

Vílla in Provence










THE VILLA

An exceptional, discreet and chic villa in Provence, located in a 300 hectare estate. There are 140 hectares of vineyards, a 22 hectare historical garden and the main villa which dates from the 17th century. The estate, from the Count and Countess of Provence, was granted its titles by Henry III in 1576. It has belonged to various dynasties who have all taken the maximum care of the estate - and this tradition continues to today. This private house, inspired by the typical villas in Tuscany, is an architectural gem. A magical and quiet estate, with centuries-old trees, that belongs to the Guénant family and currently Bérengere oversees it. It is perfect for a romantic escape, a weekend a family stay or seminaries.

The Tuscan inspired chateaux, with the exception of the towers which date from 1805, has remained unchanged. The style and features were kept even when the first floor was renovated by the architect Vallon in 1780.

The marble fountain in the main garden is attributed to Veyrier and dates from the beginning of the 17th century. The garden itself was designed in the 17th century, although part of it was redesigned in the 18th century when it was adapted to the French style.

The Oriental Garden was renovated in the 19th century. Currently the olive and almond trees here produce a wonderful oil. Since 2002, both the chateaux, the gardens and the grounds have been gradually restored and are looked after to keep the spirit of the original gardens alive.

The name has been changed back to its original one – Baulieu and so the house's title is Villa and not Chateaux. The current owner did this to honour the Jullien family.



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With authenticity made up of taste, fashion and elegance, the Villa offers 6 Prestige rooms, 2 junior suites and 3 suites. Each apartment is 30-75 m2 and is carefully decorated, respecting the historical periods of Beaulieu.Some rooms shine with a pure 1850s English style, others show of a magnificent Loius 14th style. There are also rooms dedicated to the 18th centry, Napoleon III, Spain, Provence, and even Venice and Italy – there is something for everyone. All rooms offer breath-taking views over the Alpilles mountains, the estate, the gardens and the vineyards.

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The Beaul vineyard: producing for years. With 140 hectares of vineyards in the extinct crater of Trévaressr, at 430m above sea level, it is one of the largest estates in Provence. The location: facing the Lubéron, over the valley of Durance and the abbey of Silvacaneé.

Spoil yourself and enjoy one of our massages (must be booked previously) where ever you prefer: in your suite, in the garden, etc. Visit the winery and experience a wine tasting. Take the bicycle for a ride through the estate without a guide and see the vineyards up close, enjoy a picnic which is prepared with our butler.

Make a reservation to visit the grounds in a 4x4, or look for truffles and enjoy an aperitif made from summer truffles. For those who wish, try the rosé wine and have a game of bowls on the lawn - the winner gets a bottle of wine.
